Birth to Three Years

The following are birth to three programs provided in Macomb County through the Macomb Intermediate School District (MISD).

Early On

Family services provided from birth through 36 months

Eligible infants and toddlers are those who:

- * Have developmental delays in at least one area
- * Have established conditions that may lead to delays

Macomb Infant Preschool Program

Services for children from a few weeks to three years of age

The MIPP program is a parent education program that models interventions for parents to provide their children.

Eligible children are those who:

- * Need special education services because of a medical difficulty
- * Need special education services because of a developmental delay

Early Head Start

Care and education for pregnant women and families of infants and toddlers (0-3 years old)

Program Options:

- * Home-based
- * Center-based

Eligible families are those who:

- * Are low-income
